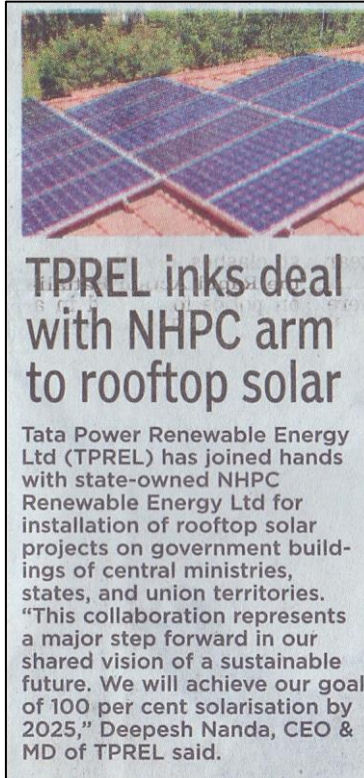


This initiative, under the PM Surya Ghar Yojna Scheme, aims for 100% solarisation of government-owned buildings by December 2025.

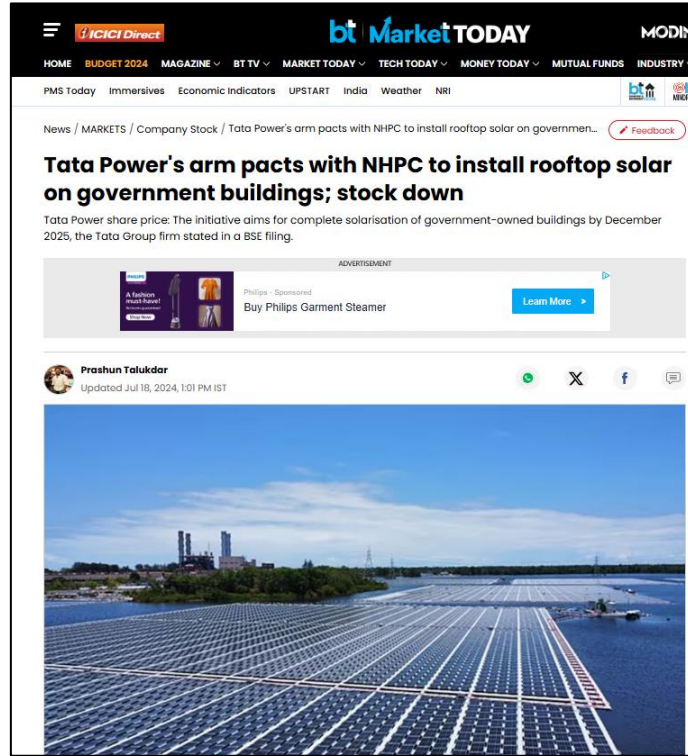
